Dear parents and carers

Term 3 is progressing with the usual busyness we expect at MLPS.

Last week we had a "lockdown" drill. It was very successful in helping us to prepare for potential emergencies or threats. The primary purpose of drills is to enhance safety and readiness in case of a serious incident. Our lockdown went off without incident and staff and students gave positive feedback about the process.

Today our Year 1 students excitedly went off to Kings Park on an excursion, Koora Koora Kaarta Koomba. They discovered how Perth (Boorloo) has changed over time and learnt about the traditional custodians, the Whadjuk Noongar people, exploring the roles in traditional Noongar society. They also learnt about the sustainable uses of our boodja, barna wer boorn (country, animals and trees). And they did not get wet!

Tomorrow we are hosting some departmental and international visitors from the Shimeikan School in Fukuoka, Japan. They will tour our beautiful school to learn more about Government schools and the public education system in Western Australia. It will be great to show them some highlights of our wonderful facilities and learning programs.

On Saturday, 4 teams of 4 students from Year 5 and 6 will be competing in a Robocup challenge at All Saints College, Bull Creek. The teams of students have designed, built, and programmed robots to perform to a piece of music. We wish them luck in what will be a great learning experience and we hope for, as well, an exciting and fun time.

Then on Tuesday 15 August MLPS is scheduled for a National Quality Standards (NQS) verification visit. A consultant from the Primary Early Childhood & Education Support Branch and a school-based verifier will be attending. The NQS provides an Australia wide approach to regulation, assessment and quality improvement for early childhood education and care and outside school hours care services across Australia. This verification will provide us with support to see how we are tracking against the NQS from an external perspective. Verifiers provide feedback to schools based on observations, discussions and evidence presented during their visit to the school. When we receive our feedback, we will share it with the school community.

I will be escaping this busyness on the 16 August as I take some overdue LSL until the end of Term 3. Jared Lawson will be Acting Principal in my absence. Christine Ashkenazy will undertake a Deputy role when she returns from leave in Week 8. We will be flexible with staffing to cover in the office, if the need arises, for the time my and Christine's leave clashes. Christine's appointment will continue into Term 4 as Anthea Phoenix takes her parental leave. While I am on leave, we are fortunate to have a capable team of educators and administrators who know our school well. They will collectively oversee the day-to-day activities and continue to uphold the high standards our school community values. Please know we have made these staffing decisions based on the consistency of the teaching and learning programs in classrooms, the need for staff to clear leave and the continuity of leadership within the school.
