### **Water**

Mud kitchen

Kids to create irrigation system from recycled pipes Creek with pump/river play/walk on a rope across a river

Shallow lake

Water slide

Metal water pump/water pump

Pond

### **Trees**

Climbing tree/really easy climbing tree

Build a treehouse with wooden bridge & a spiral deck

Wooden structure/logs to make trees accessible

Wooden bridge to a large tree stump with a deck and slide

Rope/net attached to tree

### **Birds**

Bird box

Bird nest

Aviary (budgies, cockatoo, parrots)

Bird bath

### **Climbing**

Climbing wall using smooth river rocks

### **Equipment**

Creative area where logs,, twigs, branches can be rolled/blocked to make structures.

Walking bridge over top of structure with hanging baskets and plants underneath

A hill covered with climbable rocks – surrounded by stepping stones

Collectors trail – a plank of wood or rope twisting into trails

Cubby houses incorporating colours and drawings on the side

Tunnel/Tunnel through sandpit

Sand pit
