### ORIGINS OF THE INGLEWOOD STATION

The original plan was to use the old Inglewood Police Station, which is where the name came from.

Unfortunately, that fell through, and The Inglewood Station opened at Sussex St Maylands in 2015 for students from St Peter's, Mount Lawley and Inglewood.

We added Beaufort St in 2018 and Clifton Crescent in 2022 and then became a company - The Inglewood Station Pty Ltd.

We are now just Clifton Crescent, catering for students from Mount Lawley Primary School and Maylands Peninsula.

Our aim is to provide quality care for students in a homely and comfortable environment. Almost all our staff are local and have a sound understanding of the area we are lucky enough to live in.

### THE STATION MANAGEMENT STAFF

## FEES AND CHARGES AS AT MARCH 2025

Parents are asked to commit to a full term, and fees will apply for absences. For an extended period of absence, we need two weeks' notice.

Late fees will apply for children consistently picked up after 6pm. \$10 at 6:05 pm and \$10 for every 10 minutes, or part thereof, after that.

We are a CCS registered centre, and all fees attract Childcare Subsidy if applicable. We do ask that all parents pay by Direct Debit as this is by far the most efficient way. The centre has chosen to absorb all fees associated with this.

Casual Booking fees will also apply.

Cancellation of bookings require two weeks' notice.
