

2025 CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

Dear Parents and Carers

We are pleased to inform you that the Mount Lawley Primary School Board has approved our 2025 Contributions and Charges schedule, aligning with the School Education Regulations 2000 under the School Education Act 1999. This schedule aims to provide you with a comprehensive overview of the expected expenses that might arise during the upcoming academic year.

1. Contributions

Contributions for students from Kindergarten to Year 6 in 2025 will be \$60.00 per child and are considered pertinent when supplementing the funding of curriculum areas. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our learning programs are maximised when all families contribute, as can be appreciated in the examples below:

- English- continuing reading book availability
- Mathematics- maintaining quality resource materials
- Science- replacing consumable materials for experiments
- Humanities and Social Sciences- developing current resource materials
- The Arts- replenishing consumable materials, eg- paint, card, costumes
- Physical Education- investing in accessible resources
- Library- supplementing book acquisition
- Technologies
- Languages Other Than English

Payments for school contributions can be made via your child's 2025 *Personal Items Requirements List at Campion Education*, or directly to the school (Qkr! App, EFTPOS, funds transfer, payment schedule or cash).

Voluntary P&C Contributions:

Other voluntary approved funds at Mount Lawley Primary School include P&C Contributions of:

1 Child = \$100 2 Children = \$150 3 or more Children = \$200

This voluntary contribution is administered by the P&C Committee and is used to fund and support school initiatives and focus areas that meet the needs of our children.

Charges

Charges vary across year levels depending on the nature and range of activities undertaken. The *Schedule of Maximum Charges* overleaf represents the estimated **maximum amount** that a parent/carer should anticipate being charged throughout the school year.

The Schedule of Maximum Charges includes costs associated with:

- Specific learning activities that are available to <u>all students</u> but conditional on a payment being made e.g. excursions/incursions.
- Specific learning activities that are available to <u>selected students</u>, but conditional on payment being made e.g. IMSS (instrumental music), PEAC, etc.
- Other activities that are available to all students but conditional on a payment being made e.g. graduation dinner
