Connect and Respect

Our school community is a vibrant and diverse representation of society, where children learn and grow. We rely on our local community, parents, and families to partner with us in their children's learning journey and encourage open communication.

We all share a responsibility for providing a safe, supportive, and productive environment, free from bullying, harassment, discrimination, and violence.

Parents and carers, and other visitors to our school, support safety by ensuring communication and conduct at our school and school activities is respectful. We all have the right to feel safe and be safe at school.

The Department of Education has released Connect and Respect, a suite of resources to assist school communities in setting shared and respectful expectations to enable us to continue to work together in the best interests of our children.

This includes when and how to contact the school, what you can expect from us and the behaviours that interfere with teaching and learning. These resources and guidelines will assist us to continue to build upon our culture of connection and engagement, and we will implement them to support our staff to deliver quality education at our school.

School Arrival Expectations

We remind all families that our school gates and classrooms open at 8:30am.

Twice this week we have had approximately 25 students in the Undercover Area prior to 8am. This is unsafe for our students and our community and is not fair on our staff who do not officially start their workdays until 8:30am.

No student should be on the school grounds prior to 8am as there is no supervision available. If your child arrives to school before 8am, you will receive a written notification that they have been on school grounds before it is safe to do so. Supervision begins at 8am, and we remind families that this supervision is only to be used when required by families. If your child requires daily supervision before 8:30am, please contact Inglewood Station to enquire about their before school care program.

Bike and Scooter Safety

Mount Lawley Primary School encourages safe, active travel through walking or riding to and from school to promote physical activity and positive road safety behaviours as individuals now and into the future. The staff thanks the parents/carers of MLPS for supporting safe, active travel.

It is important that all students remember to dismount their bike or scooter before entering the school grounds and walk all wheeled devices on school grounds in a direct route from the entry/exit gate to the bike/scooter racks.

We also ask our community to be aware of others using the footpaths around the school. If you are riding a bike or scooter, please be mindful of your speed on the footpaths and remember that our footpaths are shared with both school and community members, so safety is our priority.


